
a. think doing/saying the right things but realize later you've hurt someone by your actions

- to prick, pierce (metaphorically)
- sorrowful




Acts 7:54 NIV

Now when they heard this [accusation and understood its implication], they were **cut to the heart**, and they began grinding their teeth [in rage] at him.

diapriō

- to be sawn through mentally
- Feel of anger, frustration, rage



Why would we feel cut to the heart in the first place?

a. Truth in what we hear

a. Convicted by it

- message was the same
- preachers were on point
- hearers were attentive


Acts 2:36 NIV






But they **cried out with a loud voice**, and **covered their ears** and **rushed at him** with one impulse.
